Keane Foundation Partners with Wethersfield Public Schools in Grant Award

The Wethersfield Public Schools in partnership with the Richard M. Keane Foundation has received a grant of \$181,000 from the Connecticut Department of Education. The grant will support a two-year, After School Program at Wethersfield High School (WHS) and at the Silas Deane Middle School (SDMS).

The Keane Foundation currently provides programs at the SDMS in collaboration with the *Crossroads* program and Wethersfield Social and Youth Services Dept. This new grant will allow those programs to expand and to integrate new wellness, youth development and technology activities, as well as parent training programs.

The Keane Foundation currently funds

- a media center specialist three days a week after school,
- a boxing program with two instructors (one, a Wethersfield Police officer),
- a TV production program (with a SDMS teacher, a photographer and a reporter from WFSB), and
- provides transportation for students at the end of each program day.

This grant will allow additional instructors, teachers, coaches and parents to solicit and enroll additional students in our after-school programs.

Also, the Keane Foundation has partnered in a program with the Wethersfield Police Department and we hope to continue that collaboration in the future as well .
